The complainant refuses to release any information on his girlfriend. The complainant stated he received well over 20 text messages, all which had profanity and name calling words from the NOPD officer. PIB checked the NOPD's police roster for the officer and met with negative results. PIB then checked with personnel and payroll and learned that there is no officer employed by the New Orleans Police Department with the name of the alleged perpetrator.
2014-0551-I	The complainant stated he received a threatening letter via the postal service from an unknown person who he possible believed may be an employee of the police department. The complainant said the letter contained no physical threats but professional threats. The letter consisted of information pertaining to the police officer in charge of the Forensic Light Unit assigned to the New Orleans Police Department which the complainant has not been assigned to for about 10 years. The letter also indicated a supervisor allegedly left a creepy letter on a female friend's vehicle. The complainant stated because of the nature and expressed threats he wanted it brought to the attention of PIB. The complainant stated the original letter was sent to an accredited lab to obtain possible fingerprints when returned will forward the original to PIB.
2014-0695-N	Officer pulled complainant over for speeding and was unprofessional and touched her to provoke her. A preliminary investigation was conducted and the officer was identified as an employee of the Orleans Parish Levee Board.
2015-0120-I	Subject officer sent a text message to a female victim he assisted on a previous domestic violence call.

The complainant said she also went to another district to report the incident and spoke with an unknown female officer who also refused to document her incident.

There has been an ongoing harassment against her by the recruit via social media, text messages and telephone calls. The recruit has been threatening to put over social media that complainant has a sexual transmitted disease and has also threatened her to extort the money she owes to her ex-boyfriend.
2016-0113-P	Complainant stated that on Lundi Gras her son and his friends were at a parade, dancing, when they were approached by two officers. The complainant stated that her son said the officers asked them to dance again. Complainant alleges out of fear they danced.
2016-0200-N	Complainant was uncomfortable with officer coming to her house to return her identification card
2016-0233-N	The complainant stated an unknown police officer, driving a marked police vehicle, drove where she resides. The complainant stated that while she was sitting in her vehicle, the officer was staring at her. The complainant believe the officer was going to her house, but she kept driving to get lunch so she does not know if the officer went to her home or stayed in front of the house for any amount of time. The complainant stated that the officer did not say anything to her while they were passing in their cars.
2016-0518-P	The complainant stated that she and her daughter were speaking with someone about her dog. Two police officers walked up; one white male officer and the other Hispanic male officer. The white male officer interrupted her and began asking the person she was talking to questions about his dog. The other officer began staring at her and her daughter. The complainant said the officer who was staring at her made her feel like he was intimidating her as if he was going to do something to her and her daughter. The complainant said she felt it was rude and she was uncomfortable with how the officer stared at them.
